2. WET WEATHER

In the case of wet weather, the outdoor presentations may be affected. Netball ACT Staff will liaise with District Representative's on the day to coordinate alternative presentation arrangements.

3. ARRIVAL AND TEAM ASSEMBLY AREA

Your District Association will confirm with you the time your athlete is required to meet at the Team Assembly area. The Team Assembly Area is indicated on the below event map on the grass area beside the SolarHub ACT Netball Centre.

4. EVENT PARKING

Event parking is located on the areas indicated in the below venue diagram. Please be aware in between games there will be many cars and pedestrians moving throughout the venue. As you enter and exit please be aware of your surroundings and obey all road rules.



5. A REMINDER ABOUT COVID-19 GENERAL HYGIENE

- Wash and/or sanitise hands upon entry/exit and before and after using toilet facilities.
- Wash your hands frequently, cover coughs and sneezes and dispose of tissues.
- Players are required to bring their own drink bottle, towel and other personal items as require
- Each team must supply their own hand sanitiser for players to use during the competition.
- Stay home if feeling unwell. If symptoms develop onsite notify the Netball ACT Competition
 Manager who will assist you to exit the venue. Upon departure seek medical advice and follow
 the COVID-19 testing advice as per ACT Health Guidelines.
- ACT Government is strongly advising anyone who has been in specific locations identified by NSW Health on the specified dates to quarantine immediately and get tested for COVID-19 as soon as possible - even if you do not have any symptoms.

6. CLEANING

Netball ACT will undertake a thorough clean each night prior to the venue opening for competition. Cleaning and spot checks will continue to happen throughout the day with post pads and netballs cleaned in-between matches.

7. COVIDSAFE ENVIRONMENT PLAN – CAPITAL CHEMIST JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS


Netball ACT has in place a COVIDSafe Environment Plan for the competition. A copy of this plan is available on the Netball ACT website and Event Staff have been briefed in the details of this plan. The safety of all participating members and the greater Canberra community is at the forefront of

our decision making when finalising this plan.

Below is a copy of the venue layout regarding entry and exit points for players, umpires and team officials. To minimise over crowding around the entry and exit points Event Marshalls will assist teams with their movement to and from the courts.

Spectators will need to assemble in the area indicated below and wait till all teams and team officials have entered the venue. Please listen to instructions from Event Staff and remember to maintain physical distancing whilst waiting for venue entry.



8. TEAM WELLNESS SURVEY

All teams will need to complete a Wellness Survey at all training sessions and prior to entering each venue of their fixtured match. Both Players and Team Officials are required to complete the survey. All teams will be required to submit a Team Wellness Declaration, citing that all players named and Team Officials have undertaken a wellness survey and have passed.

Team Manager's must submit the Team Wellness Declaration to the Competitions Manager upon entry to the venue. If a Player or Team Official answers YES to any of the questions in the wellness survey, they should not enter the venue and should go home and isolate.

9. SPECTATORS

Spectators will be allowed, with an allocation of 23 tickets per team. To arrange a ticket please speak with your respective Team Manager or District Representative Convenor. Only spectators with tickets will be allowed to entry the venue.

Spectators will need to line up in the area marked on the above venue map (to the left of the venue doors when looking at the doors). Spectators will be allowed venue access after all teams and team officials have entered the venue.

Please note that the wooden grandstand will not be accessible to the public to allow fairness in the number of spectators across courts 1 and 4. There will be aluminium grandstands x 2 situated on courts 2 and 3, respectively.

- Seating under COVID restrictions of 1.5 social distancing only will allow for 6 persons per grandstand.
- Standing allocations will be 17 spots marked on the ground

10. COFFEE VAN

A coffee van and access to vending machines will be onsite for spectators and participants to enjoy.

11. PUBLIC AMENITIES

Are located inside the SolarHub ACT Netball Centre as indicated by the inside signage.

12. FIRST AID

Netball ACT will have a Physiotherapist onsite to assist with First Aid treatment

13. DISTRICT ASSOCIATION LIVE STREAMING

Some of the District Associations will be live streaming their matches across the day. To access these live stream events please visit the District Association Facebook pages.

14. GRANDFINAL TIMING AND SCORING

All Grand finals will be individually timed. If in the event of a draw at full time the following process for overtime occurs:

- In the event of a tied score there will be a 2-minute break during which substitutions or positional changes may occur
- 2 x 5 minutes periods will be played (no break teams to swap ends immediately and no changes can be made)
- If score at full time are still tied the game continues (without a break0 until 1 team gains a 2goal advantage

15. PHOTOGRAPHER

Netball ACT will have a photographer on site across the day who will be selling photographs. If parents are interested please see a Netball ACT Staff Member on the day for further information.
