In 2022 Netball ACT (**NACT**) will enter a team into the Australian Netball Championships (**ANC**) as the Capital Darters. The ANC program will offer chosen athletes from the ACT and other Member Organisations (**MO's**) exposure to an elite high-performance program with a focus on athlete development. The Capital Darters will provide a tangible pathway for selected athletes into Suncorp Super Netball (**SSN**), whilst also providing ACT and emerging athletes invaluable elite competition

The program is a three (3) month program commencing in July 2022 and ending in September 2022. It encompasses the Australian Netball Championships which will be held in Traralgon in August 2022.</p> <p>The position's honorarium will be as stated in the volunteer agreement.</p> <p>As a volunteer position, the working hours will vary depending on the time dictated by the program schedule. It is anticipated that most working hours will be out of hours and may include early morning, late afternoon, evening and weekend sessions.</p>
