

NACT CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

GENERAL Code of Behaviour

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity, and worth of all people involved in netball
- 2. Be ethical, fair, considerate and honest in dealing with others
- 3. Respect the decisions of the umpires
- 4. Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity
- 5. Operate within the rules and the spirit of netball
- 6. Applaud good performance
- 7. Never ridicule or abuse a player for making a mistake during competition
- 8. Make a commitment to providing quality service
- 9. Always place the safety and welfare of children above other considerations
- 10. Avoid unaccompanied and unsupervised activities with persons under 18 years of age
- 11. Comply with all relevant Australian laws (Federal and Territory)
- 12. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured
- 13. Be a positive role model
- 14. Be responsible and accountable for your conduct

UMPIRE Code of Behaviour

- 1. Umpire in accordance with the Official Rules of the Game
- 2. Treat all players, coaches, bench officials, and other umpires with respect
- 3. Place the safety and welfare of the players above all else
- 4. Maintain a high standard of personal behaviour at all times
- 5. Be a positive role model through behaviour and personal appearance projecting a favourable image of netball and umpiring at all times
- 6. Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as sexual harassment, discrimination, bullying or victimisation
- 7. Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction with other netball participants
- 8.Be honest and do not allow your qualifications/accreditation to be misrepresented



NACT CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

COACH Code of Behaviour

- 1. Operate within the rules and spirit of netball, promoting fair play
- 2. Develop a positive netball environment by emphasising enjoyment and by providing appropriate development and competitive experiences
- 3. Support opportunities for participation in the sport
- 4. Treat each person as an individual
- 5. Display control, courtesy and respect to all involved with netball
- 6. Respect the decisions of umpires, officials and administrators
- 7. Avoid unaccompanied and unsupervised one-on-one activity with people under the age of 18 years
- 8. Ensure activities, equipment and facilities are safe and appropriate to the ability level of participating players
- 9.Act with integrity and objectivity and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions
- 10. Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a safe environment
- 11. Adopt responsible behaviour in relation to alcohol and other drugs
- 12. Be honest and do not allow your qualifications/accreditation to be misrepresented

PLAYER Code of Behaviour

- 1. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain approach the official during an interval or after the competition
- 2.Learn the rules of the game and play fairly by them at all times
- 3. Control your temper. Verbal abuse is not acceptable or permitted in any sport and action may be taken by the umpires and/or supervisors
- 4. Work hard for your team at all times. Your performance will benefit and so will your team
- 5. Acknowledge good play whether it is by your team or the opposition
- 6. Treat all players both on and off the court as you would like to be treated.

 Do not interfere with or take unfair advantage of another player
- 7.Co-operate with your coach, team mates, opponents and officials at all times
- 8. Respect & acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play
