

NACT CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

GENERAL Code of Behaviour

1. Respect the rights, dignity, and worth of all people involved in netball
2. Be ethical, fair, considerate and honest in dealing with others
3. Respect the decisions of the umpires
4. Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity
5. Operate within the rules and the spirit of netball
6. Applaud good performance
7. Never ridicule or abuse a player for making a mistake during competition
8. Make a commitment to providing quality service
9. Always place the safety and welfare of children above other considerations
10. Avoid unaccompanied and unsupervised activities with persons under 18 years of age
11. Comply with all relevant Australian laws (Federal and Territory)
12. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured
13. Be a positive role model
14. Be responsible and accountable for your conduct

UMPIRE Code of Behaviour

1. Umpire in accordance with the Official Rules of the Game
2. Treat all players, coaches, bench officials, and other umpires with respect
3. Place the safety and welfare of the players above all else
4. Maintain a high standard of personal behaviour at all times
5. Be a positive role model through behaviour and personal appearance projecting a favourable image of netball and umpiring at all times
6. Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as sexual harassment, discrimination, bullying or victimisation
7. Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction with other netball participants
8. Be honest and do not allow your qualifications/accreditation to be misrepresented

NACT CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

COACH Code of Behaviour

1. Operate within the rules and spirit of netball, promoting fair play
2. Develop a positive netball environment by emphasising enjoyment and by providing appropriate development and competitive experiences
3. Support opportunities for participation in the sport
4. Treat each person as an individual
5. Display control, courtesy and respect to all involved with netball
6. Respect the decisions of umpires, officials and administrators
7. Avoid unaccompanied and unsupervised one-on-one activity with people under the age of 18 years
8. Ensure activities, equipment and facilities are safe and appropriate to the ability level of participating players
9. Act with integrity and objectivity and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions
10. Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a safe environment
11. Adopt responsible behaviour in relation to alcohol and other drugs
12. Be honest and do not allow your qualifications/accreditation to be misrepresented

PLAYER Code of Behaviour

1. Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain approach the official during an interval or after the competition
2. Learn the rules of the game and play fairly by them at all times
3. Control your temper. Verbal abuse is not acceptable or permitted in any sport and action may be taken by the umpires and/or supervisors
4. Work hard for your team at all times. Your performance will benefit and so will your team
5. Acknowledge good play whether it is by your team or the opposition
6. Treat all players both on and off the court as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with or take unfair advantage of another player
7. Co-operate with your coach, team mates, opponents and officials at all times
8. Respect & acknowledge the contribution of those who create the opportunity for you to play
